

Crisis Response Committee Notes

5/5/21

Attending: Kody Hersh (clerk), Nancy Triscritti, Cecilia Yocum, Susan Taylor, Bill Carlie (recording)

Meeting opened from the silence.

Clerk had contacted the named listeners and provided an update. Listeners were available to Friends who were distressed by the news of this event and while the need for this support was limited, Friends appreciated the availability of this support. No incident of abuse related to Javier Del Sol, or at an SEYM event has been reported to a committee member or named listener at this time.

Bill stated that he had been in touch with the SEYM office and that publication of the committee notes on the SEYM website would proceed.

Bill stated that search of the available records held by the SEYM office would continue to determine if there are further individuals who need direct contact.

Clerk provided a current summary of the direct contacts with youth participants and youth coordinators from the timeframe of concern. The fact that we are reaching out to these Friends has been well received, and our transparency in this matter appreciated. No reports of incidents of abuse at SEYM events have been received through this process. A few direct contacts remain to be made and responsibility for this effort was divided among the members.

Bill provided a summary of the current status of the listener concern and his conversations with the SEYM clerks.

The committee then discussed next steps:

- The committee intends to prepare and submit an interim progress report for June EC. Bill agreed to create a first draft for collaborative editing by the committee.
- The committee intends to look at the lessons learned through this process and their potential applicability to the ongoing update to the CAPP manual.
- The committee will work to discern recommendations for a crisis response procedure that would remain in place to allow more timely action should another incident occur in the future.

The committee scheduled its next meeting for 5/19/21 at 7:00 pm
