Clerk reviewed the agenda, there were no additions.

Clerk then proceeded to provide a summary of discussions with the named listeners, and the training session held on 4/11/21. It was the sense of the named listeners that a g-mail and google phone account for each of them dedicated to this work would be the best approach for publication in the SEYM statement. These accounts would be de-activated when this effort concludes. The committee united that this approach would provide a personal direct contact while maintaining the privacy of the personal listener contact information. The committee approved this approach, Kody will work with the listeners and incorporate this new contact information in the SEYM statement.

The committee was in unity that the statement be published on the SEYM website as soon as this new information is added.

The committee was in unity that SEYM records in regard to gathering registration minutes be reviewed to the extent available to determine which gatherings Javier Del Sol attended. Bill Carlie will work with the SEYM administrative secretary to review available records.

The committee discussed a general outline for preliminary contacts with youth coordinators and youth that appear to have attended these gatherings to the extent they can be contacted.

- Share the contents of the SEYM statement
- Ask if they have questions or concerns
- Offer resources as provided in the SEYM Statement
- Update contact list and provide brief summary of concerns, if any.

The committee then discussed a concern brought forward by one of the listeners. This listener volunteer had experienced a difficult interaction with a member at our gathering. The committee was in unity in support of these listener volunteers and discussed how we may support their important work. For these volunteers to be successful it is important that the SEYM community remain in unity supporting their work.

As a means to support this unity in our community, the committee agreed that our notes will be published on the SEYM website.
