Southeastern Yearly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends Yearly Business Meeting 2020 Executive Committee Meeting 9 Fifth Month 2020

Minutes

The meeting began with worship at 2 pm.

Bill Carlie read from John Woolman from the silence.

Friends introduced themselves and their roles.

Bill gave some Zoom tips, including a request to keep ourselves muted when not speaking, and to use the hand raised feature to be recognized.

Ed Lesnick presented the Nominating Committee report (attached). The committee has met since the report was repaired. Some additional names will be added. Vicki Carlie pointed out that the position of CAPP coordinator was the responsibility of Executive Committee. Nominating Committee is continuing to search for a Friend to fill this position. Ed encouraged Friends to help with this nomination.

Susan Wade gave the Yearly Meeting Secretary's report (attached). Friends accepted the report and are grateful for Susan's gifts, joy, and work.

Vicki Carlie gave the report of the Gathering Committee (attached). Right after the specially called meeting of the Executive Committee on the 11th day of the Third Month, Andrea Hoskins contacted the Warren Willis United Methodist Camp and Conference Center (WWUMCCC) f/k/a the Life Enrichment Center (LEC) and was able to have our deposit moved to the 2021 Gathering.

The committee and staff did create a virtual "mini gathering." A follow up survey indicated overwhelming enthusiasm for continuing virtual workshops, worship sharing, and other ongoing online programs. The Gathering Committee believes the question of whether to continue to offer virtual events should be discussed by Executive Committee or the wider SEYM community. Perhaps one workshop and one worship sharing a month would be sustainable, but the Gathering Committee believes this to be beyond its responsibility. Friends believe this is a good idea, but will require a coordinator or committee to make this a good outreach tool. An *ad hoc* committee from the Executive Committee might coordinate this for a year. This will require staff time as well. Kody reports that he has some time for this work.

20YMEC01 Executive Committee appoints an *ad hoc* committee of Cece Yocum, Brian Olson, Stephen Riddle, Nancy Triscritti, and Kody Hersh to coordinate the presentation of virtual workshops that were already prepared for Yearly Meeting Gathering, as well as virtual worship sharing, between now and Winter Interim Business meeting, and to report to WIBM on future possibilities. APPROVED. Kody Hersh presented the Youth and Young Adult Coordinator's report. A full report will be prepared for the fourth or fifth Yearly Meeting plenary. At this time, he asks to be lifted in the Light for guidance as to his work going forward since there is little clarity about when in-person events can resume. He asks also that the Nominating Committee continue to be held in the Light in its work to find a CAPP coordinator. He plans to be in touch with Friends to be CAPP trained, as our community is strong when we have a group that is trained to work with our youth. Friends accepted the report with gratitude for the work Kody does.

Jerry Knutson presented the Half Yearly Meeting report (attached). Brian Olson will become clerk of HYM in 2021. There is, of course, uncertainty about an in-person meeting in 2020. Friends accepted the report.

Joel Cook presented the Treasurer's Report. The third quarter report is not yet prepared. Joel and Dianne Langan are able to work together from a distance, and a report will be ready soon. Joel has been in touch with a CPA firm to get a new letter of engagement to move forward with the review of policies and procedures. Through the end of the Third Month, we are about \$10,000 to the good. Friends accepted the report.

Peter Schmidt reported for the Finance Committee. Apportionments are generally done after the budget is approved. Joel Cook gives the approximate apportionment as \$143 per member (1/2 per attender). There was particular discussion about how to handle Gainesville's apportionment vis-à-vis the absorption of Jacksonville Worship Group. Friends accepted the Finance Committee report.

Ed Lesnick, membership recorder, explained that Friends who are part of a worship group but members of a monthly meeting are not included as attenders at the worship group.

Jack Bradin reported for Trustees. Neil Andersen will complete Jack's term as clerk so that he can serve as assistant clerk. The Trustees investments are okay—Friends Fiduciary has so far weathered the uncertainty well. Jack also explained that Trustees want to offer a fund to assist meetings and Friends in these extraordinary times. A procedure would allow these funds to be accessed more quickly than through YM business meeting.

20YMECC02 Executive Committee appoints an *ad hoc* committee of Jack Bradin, Neil Andersen, Nancy Triscritti, Bill Carlie, and a representative to be named from Peace & Social Concerns Committee, to develop a specific plan for the Trustees' funds proposed to assist Friends and Meetings with needs related to the Covid-19 pandemic, to be presented at a YM plenary session in the coming month. APPROVED

Ed Lesnick reported as the Membership Recorder. Two meetings have done a very thorough job of identifying who they identify as an attender. In overall numbers we are about the same as last year. There will be a more detailed report at a later plenary. Friends accepted the report.

Cece Yocum stated that Peace & Social Concerns has met recently and will have a report for DIA before its plenary.

Nancy Triscritti reported that Worship and Ministry has no report at this time.

Gathering Committee Report

Executive Committee Meeting 9 Fifth Month 2020

The Gathering Committee would like to report a couple of key items to the YBM Executive Committee Meeting.

First, some good news: Our clerk, Andrea Hoskins, called the Warren Willis United Methodist Camp & Conference Center after our March 11th EC meeting to cancel the in-person Gathering. After some discussion, the WWUMCC agreed to credit this year's deposits on the camp to our 2021 Gathering. We have a good relationship with them; and they like us as clients, and want to have us come back.

Second, we want to report on the survey we conducted after the Virtual Mini-Gathering (VMG). The survey, <u>SEYM Virtual Gatherings: Looking Ahead</u>, gathered feedback both from Friends who had attended the VMG, and those who had not. About 65 Friends took the survey.

One key takeaway was the overwhelming enthusiasm for SEYM to continue to offer programming online – worship sharing, workshops, and other virtual events – even after we are able to start meeting in person again.

The Gathering Committee, working with Kody Hersh as Coordinator, is offering 4 Worship Sharing sessions this month in support of YBM sessions.

There are a few more workshops, that had been planned for our in-person Gathering, which are 'ready-to-go' to be offered online. However, the committee is not prepared to schedule them at this time.

We feel that the question of offering ongoing online program is beyond the Gathering Committee's responsibilities, and that it would best be addressed by the Executive Committee, and/or the larger body of SEYM.

Shall SEYM continue to offer worship sharing, workshops, and/or other virtual events in the coming weeks and months? For the duration of social distancing? On a continuing basis?

The Virtual Mini-Gathering, held April 8-12, was a huge success. 112 Friends attended the sessions; many were present for almost all the sessions, while others dropped in for workshops that fit their schedule or interests. We also note that many participants were Friends we don't usually see at the in-person Gathering. <u>See the full report></u>
