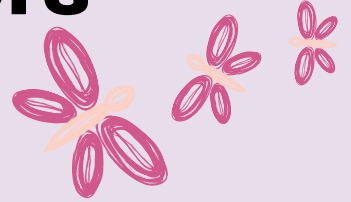

Information for parents and sponsors



- **Supervision:**
 - Youth program is for children 0-18 years
 - Youth must have an adult present who is responsible for them during their entire stay
 - Youth workers are available to supervise children from 9-11:30 am
Parents are responsible for their own children at other times
- **Paperwork:**
 - Sponsors must be named on the registration form
 - Youth must turn in a signed Parental Consent Form at registration
 - Canoeing, swimming, and ropes activities require signed waivers
 - Photo ID not necessary
- **Locations:**
 - Most activities take place in Tipp Pavilion
 - Meals are in cafeteria
 - Other locations will be posted
- **What to bring:**
 - Casual clothes for workshops, talent show, and dancing
 - Swim clothes and towels
 - Comfortable clothes for walking and playing outdoors
 - Extra shoes for canoeing
